Exciting 'Triathlon' competition unfolds at Heavenly Views Yeongdo

To be held in Amir Park and along the sea route, August 5 to 6

Between the three-way intersection in front of P.Ark ~ Korea Maritime & Ocean University entrance, about 1.7km section, will be closed off to traffic, between 6:40 a.m. of the 5th(Sat) & 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. of the 6th(Sun) Citizens Participation Concert (Ailee, Burning Soda, SoonSoonHee, Joosiq, Team H) at 7:00 p.m. at Amir Park special stage on the 5th

From August 5 to 6, the 'WT Yeongdo World Triathlon World Cup 2023' competition, challenging the limits of the bodies and minds, will be held against the backdrop of beautiful coastal scenery.

The World Triathlon World Cup is an international competition in which male and female elite athletes, within the 65th place in the world ranking, swim, cycle, and run in succession; it is going to be broadcast live on the Internet in 140 countries around the world.

Triathlon is a combined word of tri, which means three, and athlon, which means competition, and is notorious for being the most demanading sport. It is also called the Ironman triathlon because it is a race that is conducted in succession with no rest in between.

The competition will start with an elite sprint (swimming 750m, cycling 20km, running 5km) competition at 7:00 a.m. on the 5th at Amir Park, the National Maritime Museum, and the neighboring sea route; This will be followed by a club sprint competition (same as the elite course) at 6:00 a.m. on the 6th and the standard distance competition (swimming 1.5km, cycling 40km, running 10km).

In addition, a citizens participation concert (Ailee, Burning Soda, SoonSoonHee, Joosiq, Team H) will be held at 7:00 p.m. on the 5th at the special stage of Amir Park to commemorate the hosting of the Yongdo World Triathlon World Cup and also wishing to host the Busan World Expo 2030; it is expected to be a festival venue not only for the participating teams but also for everyone.

Traffic is controlled for the smooth running of the two days of the competitions.

Starting from the three-way intersection in front of P.Ark to the entrance to Korea Maritime & Ocean University entrance, about 1.7Km section, will be closed off to traffic, between 6:40 a.m. and 10:10 a.m. on the 5th and between 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. on the 6th.

Accordingly, vehicle traffic must detour toward Taejongdae via the Dongsam three-way intersection and the three-way intersection in front of Dongsam Church; police and safety personnel will be deployed at the control points and major intersections to help vehicles flow smoothly and minimize inconvenience to residents.

Yeongdo Mayor of Gu said "Through the competition, we will promote Yeongdo, which has a heavenly blessed natural environment, as a mecca for marine leisure cultural tourism to the world, and expect it will serve as a good opportunity to leap forward as an international sports city." and "It will also be a meaningful event that contributes to our efforts to host the Busan World Expo."

Population Day 2023 celebration event held

Awareness and forming consensus in the population crisis era



Yeongdo District held the Population Day 2023 ceremony at the main auditorium of the Gu office on July 10 with the participation of about 250 people, including Yeongdo Mayor of Gu, Ahn Seongmin, Busan City Council Chairman, Yeongdo-Gu Council Chairman and council members, and the heads from various departments of Gu office.

Yeongdo District was designated as a Depopulated Area by the government in 2021. This event, held for the first time at the Gu level, was to increase residents' interest in low birth rate aging and to spread understanding of the population crisis.

During the first event of the day, individuals institutions cooperations that have contributed to the vitalization of the population in the region were awarded meritorious commendations:

▲ Kang Hee-yeong, Individual category (Creating a friendly atmosphere for marriage in the community, childbirth, and child-rearing, Chairman of Yeongdo Mom) ▲ Social Welfare Corporation Hyewon Yeongdo-Gu Senior Welfare center, Institutional category (Aging Response Area, Director Park Seok-won) ▲ World Food Co., Ltd., Corporate category (family-friendly company, Chief representative Shin Ju-sik).

During the second event that followed, a population-education musical 'rehearsal', developed by the Ministry of Health and Welfare and the Population Health and Welfare Association, was

prepared to increase the interest of the attendees; the musical was developed to form positive values for marriage·childbirth·childrearing and to improve awareness of population problems through education from the perspective of work·life balance, family values, and gender equality.

Meanwhile, apart from the Gu-office event, Yeongdo District ran Population Week until July 13. They visited and performed the musical 'Population-Education Musical Visiting Schools' to 1,300 students at six schools in the district that submitted a request; they visited Sangri Elementary School on the 10th and Cheonghak Elementary School, Bongsam Elementary School, Yeongdo Jeil Middle School, Busan Nam Middle School, and Busan Health High School till the 13th.

Yeongdo Mayor of Gu said: "We will do our utmost to turn a crisis into an opportunity by restoring regional vitality through an increase in the living population, expanding investment for future generations, strengthening the residential environment, and working diligently to attract a visiting-living population."

On the other hand, Population Day began on July 11, 1987: it was designated, to commemorate the world's population reaching 5 billion and raise awareness of population problems, by the United Nations Development Agency. It was designated in Korea in 2011 and we celebrated 12th Population Day this year.

Installation of 2 LED display boards for Gu publicity

Expect to effectively convey the public services and administrative issues





Yeongdo District installed the 'LED Display Boards for Gu Publicity', which can effectively inform residents of public services and administrative issues; the full-scale services started in July.

The locations of the two Gu publicity LED boards, one installed in Yeongdo Gu Hall and another in Yeongseon 2-dong Community Center, were selected after taking installation environment such as the number of nearby visitors, the factors obstructing visibility, the durability of the walls, etc. into consideration.

To enhance the visual effect, the electronic display board is 3.5m wide, 2m high, and 0.23m thick.

To prevent light pollution, the electronic display board is operated from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. every day; it displays Gu events, major policies, weather information, disaster situations, etc.

An official from Yeongdo District said "We expect residents to be able to receive useful information easily and quickly," and "We will continue to implement lifestyle-oriented administration that eliminates inconveniences in the lives of residents."

Opening of Blueport 2021, Coffee Complex Culture Space

Yeongdo District in July opened 'Blue Port 2021', a coffee complex culture space.

Blue Port 2021 was established near Bongrae-dong Wharf (138 Bongrae Naru-ro) to lay the foundation for the coffee industry as a future high-value-added industry and to brand Yeongdo as a coffee city.

In the creative space on the first floor, cultural events, coffee-related workshops, etc. can be held, and the cafe showroom can be used as a space to promote display local coffee and carry out coffee education.

The coffee lab and roasting room on the 2nd floor, equipped with professional equipment, will be used to carry out coffee education programs such as coffee extraction and roasting. It will be open to those preparing to obtain barista qualifications; it is expected to make a great contribution to raising local coffee experts.

The coffee library, a rest area open to the public, is equipped with coffee-related books and magazines, so anyone interested in coffee can freely read related books.

In order to rent a facility, an application for the use of the facility must the made, and a user fee, 5,000won~20,000won depending on the facility, must be paid. Yeongdo Mayor of Gu said: "I hope that Blueport 2021

will help all those who like coffee and want to become experts in coffee-related fields and those who run coffee-related businesses and help become a foothold for the development of the local coffee industry and the spread of coffee culture."



The 16th National **Youth English Speech Contest held**



Yeongdo District held the '16th National Youth English Speech Contest' at the Yeongdo Gu Hall Auditorium on July 13 to help young people grow into talents equipped with not only English proficiency but also writing skills and leadership.

24 students, out of 256 applicants, advanced to the finals rounds of the contest after a preliminary round; the contest was hosted by Yeongdo District and Yeongdo-Gu International Exchange Council (Chairman Choi Dong-han) and sponsored by Busan Metropolitan City, Busan Metropolitan City Office of Education, and Busan Seobu District Office Of Education.

In the finals held on this day, parents and friends watched and cheered all the speakers and the atmosphere of the contest was further enhanced with youth dance club performances, an English quiz event, etc.

The top prize in the high school division was given to Yu Hamin, a 2nd-year student at Busan Jungang High School; the speech topic was 'Welcome is it your first in Busan'; he introduced the beautiful places and the representative dishes of Busan to a foreign friend he met on a trip to England. Korean Language Lesson

Korean language education conducted at Yeong-do-Gu Family Center will begin its second semester on September 11 (Mon). Korean language education helps married immigrant women and their children to adapt to Korean society through opportunities to experience Korean culture in addition to



reading, listening, and writing Hangeul on their own.

The available educational courses are ▲ Course for children in immigrant families ▲ Local culture utilization course ▲ Topic (Reading) ▲ Topic II (Listening) ▲ Topic (writing) ▲ Topic I (Listening). The classes are divided into beginner, intermediate, and advanced classes through a pre-test. For married immigrants, the classes are for the Topic test, and for the children of immigrants, classes necessary for life and education in Korea, such as conversation and dictation, are provided. In addition, both online and offline education will be conducted this year as well, along with play education to improve abilities such as one midterm assignment and one examination a month.

Instructor Bae Jin-hwa of Korean language education at Yeongdo-Gu Family Center said "The classes are comfortable and fun where you can easily learn Korean language and carry out a dialogue while forming a similar consensus with Married Immigrant Women from other countries."

Childcare Support Project

In order to alleviate the parental burden of raising children, under the age of 12, among families with parenting gaps such as dual-income parents, this center provides a 'Childcare Service' in which a child caregiver who has completed specialized education visits the homes. In the case of an application for childcare, it is necessary to first apply for social security benefits at the nearest community center or welfare site, then receive a notice of government support and service type decision, and then issuance of a Citizens Happiness Card is required. Afterward, if you register as a member of the childcare user homepage and apply for the services, you can receive childcare support.

Available service types are \(\begin{align*} \text{Hourly service} \) (Basic type) \(\begin{align*} \text{Hourly service} \) (Comprehensive type) \(\begin{align*} \text{All-day service} \) for children infected with diseases. The government support, support hour, and user amount, for each type is different depending on the median income standard.

Nam Hee-eun, Director of Yeongdo-Gu Family Center, said "We will strive to improve the quality of life and create a child-rearing-friendly local environment through the work-life balance of guardians by providing childcare support services to Yeongdo-Gu families."
